**COMMISSIONERS' COURT BUDGET HEARING
SEPTEMBER 12, 2011**

Judge Garner opened the floor for any questions or comments in regards to the proposed budget for the upcoming fiscal year, October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012.

Commissioner Wade inquired as to the possibility of adding a \$2000.00 line item to accumulate funding in order to pay for construction of a restroom facility at Allison Park. He stated that he had spoken with Sam Kent in regards to a possible grant from the Texas Parks and Wildlife, but, would have to show that the County is trying to set aside money for the project. Commissioner Cavaness also expressed the need for the facility and remarked that it would most likely alleviate the many complaints. Judge Garner commented that it was entirely up to the Commissioners to set money aside to fund the facility, but, felt that it was sending a bad, contradicting message to the citizens of Sutton County; due to the fact that they would be funding a recreational project and did not give County employees a raise nor help fund the building the Sutton County Days Association is constructing at the Rodeo Arena. She went on to say that possibly if values were better next year, the project could be considered. It was the consensus of the Court to revisit the project during next year's budget workshops. She informed the court that she would send a letter to Mr. Kent, explaining the final decision.

Judge Garner reported that money for a time clock had been added back into the budget, but did not have the exact figures as of yet.

With no further questions or comments, Judge Garner Closed the hearing.
