ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

WHEREAS, the County Judge finds that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated area of the County create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the County Judge of Sutton County that all outdoor burning is prohibited in the unincorporated area of the for 90 days from the date of the adoption of the Order, unless the restrictions are terminated earlier based on a determination made by: (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) planting or harvesting of agricultural crops; or, (4) burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Natural Resources Code §153.048 and meet the standards of Natural Resources Code §153.047.

In accordance with Local Government Code §352.081(h), a violation of this Order is a Class C Misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
