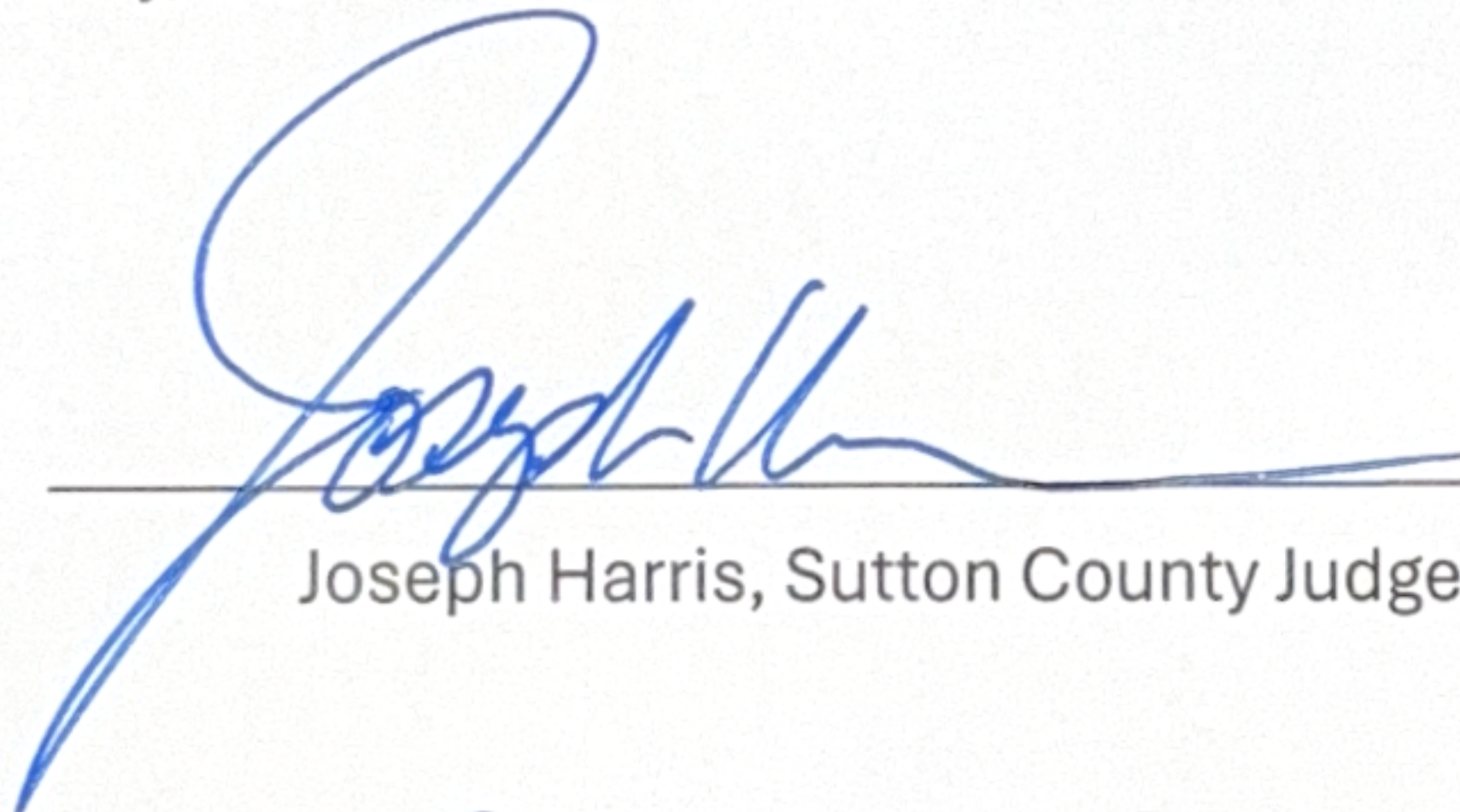
WHEREAS, Sutton County on the 17th day of July 2026 has suffered widespread or severe damage ^{PAM THORP COUNTY & DISTRICT CLERK SUTTON COUNTY, TEXAS} of life or property resulting from **severe flooding due to heavy rainfall, flash flooding, and river flooding**;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Sutton County has determined that it is necessary to renew the Declaration of Disaster set forth by the interim County Judge on July 17, 2026, due to extraordinary measures that must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

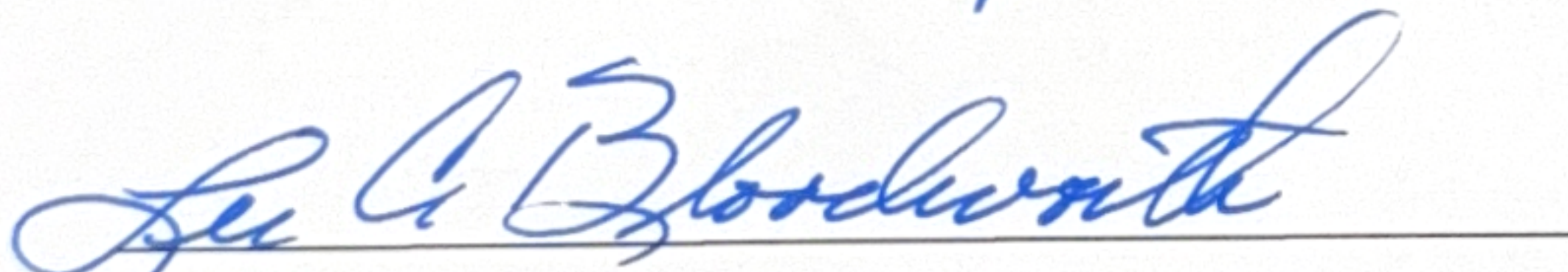
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SUTTON COUNTY:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Sutton County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code;
2. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Sutton County Clerk;
3. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster continues the activation of the county emergency management plan;
4. Pursuant to §262.024 of the Local Government Code, this declaration of local state of disaster, grants the exemption by Order of the Commissioners Court;
5. That this declaration shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.

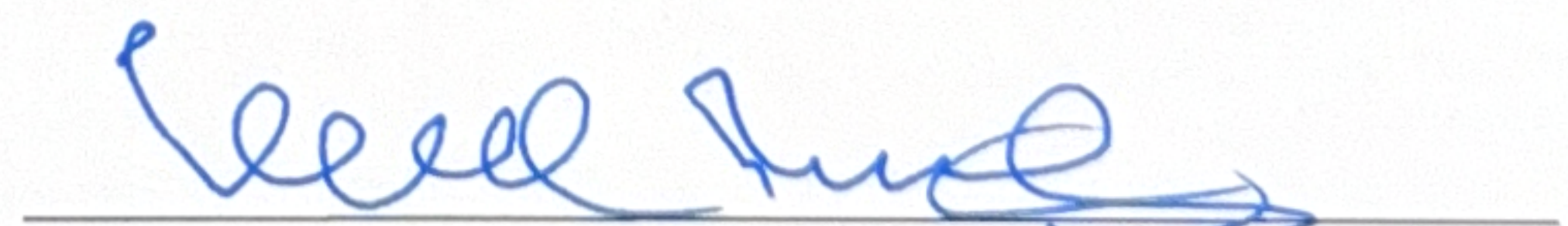
