Re: Selection of Appraisal District Directors

There are five directors to be appointed to serve a two-year term beginning January 1, 2026. The Sutton County, Sonora I.S.D. and City of Sonora participate in the district and may nominate candidate for each position to be filled.

The number of votes allocated to a voting unit is based on the ratio of its tax levy in the preceding year to the total tax levy of all voting units.

Calculation of votes to select five directors.
